Its current research program covers about twenty individual projects across a broad range of current policy concerns (the main research areas and the research programme are outlined on our web site). Bruegel's work involves close interaction and collaboration with the research community. Bruegel currently has a vacancy for a research fellow in the area of climate change and energy. S/he will be conducting research projects in the field in connection with policy issues of relevance in Europe and globally and collaborate with other Bruegel fellows working in related fields.

Candidates for this vacancy need to have a strong background in economic research, ideally in industrial organisation and regulation; command of state-of-the-art empirical techniques ; experience with energy and climate change issues, from a policy

making institution and/or from research. Exposure to policy discussions would be desirable. The position is for a full-time resident.
