In a number of countries, state-owned enterprises (SOEs) constitute a significant share of the economy and are dominant or even monopolistic players in certain industries. But the crisis has caused severe fiscal tensions. As a result some countries have started to privatise, while others are trying to reorganise SOEs in order to make them more efficient and thereby ensure higher budget revenues. The pros and cons of each approach will be discussed at the workshop.



The workshop will bring together high-level representatives from EU governments, international organisations, think-tanks and academic institutions to discuss the 'privatise-or-reorganise' issue and the design of related policy strategies.
