We would like to invite you to attend the Smart Power Market panel debate hosted by Bruegel on January 12, 2010 from 11:45 to 14:00. As you may know, European member states are planning to connect 104 GW of wind power by 2020 to the power distribution system. Most of the debate so far has centered on grid expansion, but just as important is the power distribution system, and whether and how it will accommodate the integration of renewables.

Climate Policy Initiative (CPI) and Bruegel will be inviting key policymakers and power sector players to attend this discussion. **Karsten Neuhoff** will be sharing the results of CPI's recent EU research project, which addresses power market design options, and more specifically how these options address the integration of wind production. The work compares various European zonal and market coupling systems with nodal or locational marginal pricing systems such as those used in the U.S.
